- 1. The majority of public liability claims received relate to incidents arising from the Highway. In 2016-17, 85% of the public liability claims received related to incident arising from the Highway, 9% (54 claims) were in respect of historic child abuse, 2% (15 claims) related to accidents in schools, the balance were spread across the Council.
- **2.** Employers liability claims arise across the Council. The figures include claims for deafness caused by historic exposure to noise and other disease claim such as mesothelioma.
- 3. Property claims mainly arise from schools. They include fire, flood and escape of water. The claim numbers are reducing partly due to improved risk management and partly due to the decline in local authority schools.
