 - Process for review/ challenge
 - When should we not be in a partnership
 - To consider whether available funding is delivering outcomes
 - To examine whether partnerships are providing value for money and delivering improvements/outcomes -and if appropriate to consider alternative ways of working.
- 3. To achieve these objectives the Review has heard from a number of sources of information including
 - the Nottinghamshire Partnership
 - district and borough local strategic partnerships
 - district and borough Overview and Scrutiny Committees
 - Nottinghamshire County Council
 - Worcestershire Total Place Pilot
