### **INSTALLATION OF A SYNTHETIC MULTI-USE GAMES AREA WITH FLOODLIGHTING AT ASHFIELD COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL, SUTTON ROAD, KIRKBY- IN- ASHFIELD, NOTTINGHAMSHIRE**
