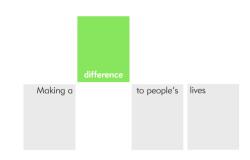
Size and Scale

The Vision

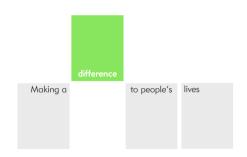


A service arranged and delivered which

- Are valued by those who receive them, by local communities and by elected representatives



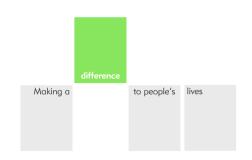
