




First time entrants

Case Study - TC

- 17 year old male
- On an order with YJS for violent offences
- Main areas of concern:
 - Offending behaviour
 - Family and personal relationships
 - Peer influences
 - Substance Misuse
 - ETE / Constructive Leisure time
 - Accommodation



Work undertaken with TC

- Assistance with accommodation
- CAMHs intervention with mum and TC
- Offending behaviour work
- Support re ETE (Rapid English, college applications)
- Substance Misuse Intervention
- Referred to Princes Trust



Outcomes for TC

- Settled and furnished accommodation
- Improved relationships with parents
- No offending
- Abstinence from substances
- Completed Princes Trust course
- Started college course in engineering
- Sat on interview panel for YJS recruitment
- Order revoked early for good progress
