WESTMINSTER ENERGY. ENVIRONMENT AND TRANSPORT FORUM KEYNOTE SEMINAR, FUTURE OF THE NATIONAL GRID, THURSDAY 17 JUNE 2010, CENTRAL LONDON

1. Purpose of Report

1.1 To consider the attendance of Councillor S Creamer at the Future of the National Grid Seminar in London on 17th June 2010.

2. Information and Advice

- 2.1 Smart grids are a "key plank in the United Kingdom's transition to a low carbon economy", according to the Government. This seminar offers an opportunity to examine the transition process. Planned sessions review the need to transform the electricity grid by 2050 and examine remaining barriers to transition as well as assessing opportunities for energy trading and the wider impact on consumers and industry.
- 2.2 Councillor Creamer would like to attend the event to assist him in his role as Opposition Spokesperson for the Environment and Sustainability.
- 2.3 The cost of attendance is estimated as:-

Seminar fee	£190.00
Travel (2 nd class rail at peak time)	£140.00
Total	£330.00

These costs can be met from Members' Allowance budget.
