USE OF URGENCY POWERS

Purpose of the Report

1. To notify the Council where urgency powers have been used.

Information and Advice

2. The Chief Executive took an urgent decision using his delegation CEX1.1 to approve the acceptance of an offer to buy land at Annesley Road, Hucknall. The decision was urgent because the buyer wished to exchange contracts within a short timescale.
3. In reaching the decision, the following members were consulted: Cabinet Member for Finance and Property, Leader of the County Council, Leader of the Labour Group, Leader of the Liberal Democrat and Social Democrat Group, Leader of the Independent Group and Chair of the Social Care and Health Standing Committee.
4. The decision was entered on the delegated decision log on 25 October 2011. Because this was an urgent decision, it was not subject to any call-in period.
