Report of the Chair of the Flooding Select Committee

Evidence and Information Requested by the Flooding Select Committee

Purpose of the report

1. To indicate to the Flooding Select Committee a list of remaining areas on which it plans to receive evidence.

Background

2. On 12 March 2007 the Flooding Select Committee identified a number of issues about which it needed to hear evidence before it could proceed to draft a final report.

Areas of Evidence

- 3. The Select Committee has commissioned verbal briefing from departmental officers on the following issues:
 - Plans for the development of a Sustainable Urban Drainage (SUDs) policy
 - Sewers in Nottinghamshire an update on maintenance responsibility and Severn Trent
 - Frequency of roadside gully cleansing detail on policy and procedures in place
 - Flooding resulting in bridge closure (e.g. at Kelham and Gunthorpe) and the need for a further Trent crossing
