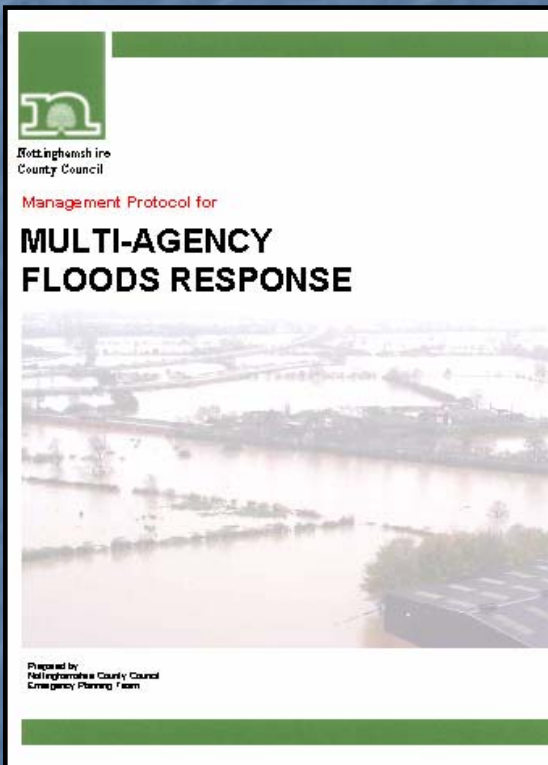
Management Protocol for Multi-Agency Floods Response

- Evacuation
- Water Rescue
- Recovery After Floods

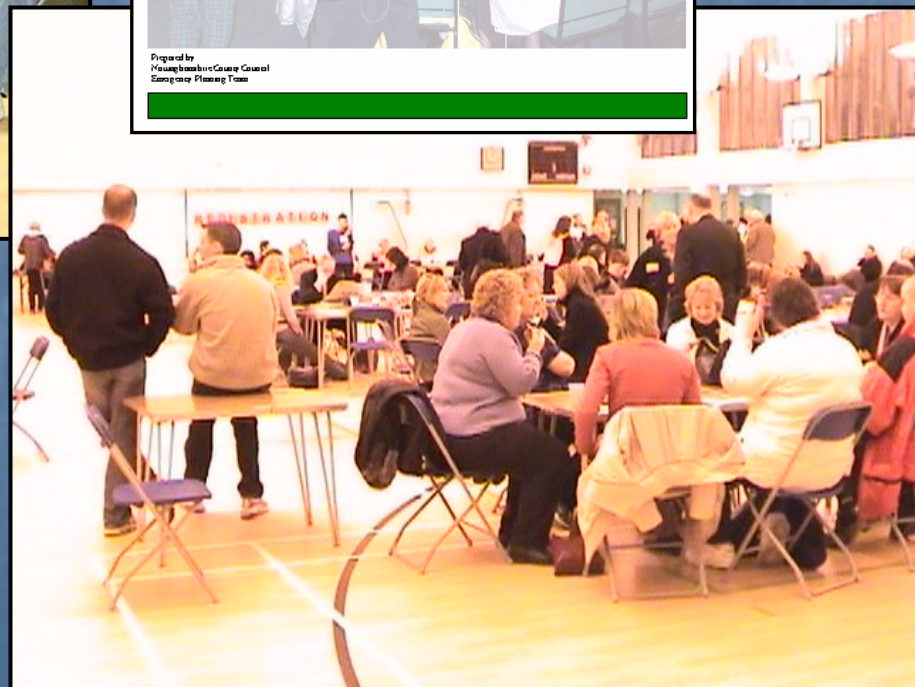
