# NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL STRATEGIC PROGRAMMES

## 1. <u>Purpose of the Report</u>

1.1 To inform members of the public of the scope and direction of the five strategic programmes that underpin the overall strategic plan.

## 2. <u>Background</u>

- 2.1 The County Council's current strategic plan "All together better" covers the period 2006-2010. To support the strategic plan and act as the primary vehicle for defining and delivering strategic change, five strategic programmes have been developed.
- 2.2 The five strategic programmes cover the following:
