REPORT OF THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE

NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL STRATEGIC PROGRAMMES

1. Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 To inform members of the public of the scope and direction of the five strategic programmes that underpin the overall strategic plan.

2. Background

- 2.1 The County Council's current strategic plan "All together better" covers the period 2006-2010. To support the strategic plan and act as the primary vehicle for defining and delivering strategic change, five strategic programmes have been developed.

- 2.2 The five strategic programmes cover the following:

- i) Service Development - improving our key services
- ii) Community Strategy - developing our links with partners and the community at large.
- iii) Access & Communications – improving our access and communications with the public
- iv) Member Support – supporting the democratic processes
- v) Resources - improving the efficiency and effectiveness of the County Council.

3. Performance Issues

- 3.1 All five strategic programmes have clear deliverables, and agreed dates for completion. Each programme is led by a senior manager within the County Council with Member scrutiny to ensure successful delivery and alignment to the overall strategic plan.
