For the purpose of:

The provision of Civil Enforcement Officers (Notts) and supporting Enforcement Agents (bailiffs) to pursue unpaid debt (3 counties).

NOTTS PARKING PARTNERSHIP

- Working collaboration between NCC and Districts/Boroughs formed 2008
 - NCC provides countywide services;
 - Procurement of enforcement services, enforcement services and software supplier.
 - The Central Processing Unit (back office)
 - CCTV car
 - Bus lane enforcement
 - Residents & Special Access Permits
 - Account management
 - Districts/Boroughs provide local services;
 - Parking Manager to determine beats/hours/local issues
 - Decisions on off-street PCNs
- Districts responsible for all <u>off-street PCNs/NCC for on-street & for account balancing</u>



ENFORCEMENT SERVICES CONTRACT(CEOs)

hat have we done;

Tender for the supply of trained & equipped CEOs for Nottinghamshire

On-street and off-street under terms of Traffic Management Act

Services contract - 5+ years at agreed hourly rate

Contractually managed by NCC using KPIs and countywide enforcement policy

Locally managed by Districts/Boroughs (hours/beats)



ENFORCEMENT AGENTS (BAILIFFS) CONTRACT

What have we done;

- Tender for the provision of Enforcement Agents (bailiffs)
- Framework contract every 4 years (current 2015-19); no cost to LA
- Used by all partner Authorities of the CPU including DCC & LCC (23 in total)
- Taking Control of Goods 2014 much improved legislative framework
- Managed by CPU warrants allocated on recent performance.



TENDER ISSUES

Enforcement Services

- **Public Services contract**
- Only small number of suppliers
- 2 previous tenders (2008-2014;2014-2020)
- Price & Quality evaluation-2 stage

Enforcement Agents

- Framework Contract
- Large number of suppliers but only relatively few with national coverage ;procurement can be challenging
- After TCG, 100% on quality
- Work allocated equitably to start then on performance
- Also used for Sundry Debt by NCC.



TENDER OPPORTUNITIES

- NCC has good experience of both tender & award processes
- Opportunity to procure Enforcement Services in 2020 to be available to other Authorities
- Opportunity to widen framework of Enforcement Agents tender in 2019
- For buying in Authorities then using the CPU, this will reduce our unit costs. Others to pay a joining fee.
- Cons would be increased potential for spoiling challenges
