REPORT OF THE CABINET MEMBER FOR SOCIAL SERVICES

HOME CARE IN NOTTINGHAMSHIRE – IMPLEMENTATION OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE SELECT COMMITTEE STUDY GROUP

1. Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 The purpose of the report is to inform members of the Social Services Standing Select Committee of the content and outcome of the Cabinet Member for Social Services report in response to the recommendations of the Select Committee's Study Group on home care services.

2. Information and Advice

- 2.1 The report, a copy of which can be seen at Appendix 1, was taken to Cabinet on 21st July, 2004.
- 2.2 The Cabinet Member welcomed the work of the Select Committee and valued the recommendations.
- 2.3 All recommendations were accepted. However, the report indicated that any proposal which requires financial support has to be considered in the light of the Social Services budget.
- 2.4 Cabinet approved the response of the Cabinet Member for Social Services.

3. Future Work

- 3.1 A detailed work plan for the implementation of the recommendations will be developed.
- 3.2 Costing of all recommendations which require financial support will be prepared to enable consideration as part of budget planning.

4. Recommendations

- 4.1 It is recommended that the Select Committee considers the Cabinet Member for Social Services' response to the recommendations of the Home Care Study Group.

5. Recommendations of the Chair of the Social Services Standing Select Committee

- 5.1 It is recommended that a progress report be brought back to the Select Committee in 6 months time.
