Report of the Chair of the Education Development Plan – Attainment and Targets - Select Committee

Education Development Plan Select Committee – Draft Final Report

1. Purpose of the report

1.1 This report provides the Select Committee with draft conclusions and recommendations from its scrutiny review of issues around attainment and targets in the Education Development Plan. The Select Committee is invited to discuss this draft report, making any amendments as necessary, and then to agree a final report, including recommendations, which will be referred to the County Council's Cabinet.

2. Background

- 2.1 During this scrutiny review Members have visited 4 further Nottinghamshire schools as a follow up to a scrutiny report, produced last year, on attainment and targets in Nottinghamshire schools compared to our statistical neighbours. The County Council's former Education and Lifelong Learning Select Committee referred the original scrutiny report to the County Council's Cabinet on 7 June 2006.
- 2.2 At the meeting of this Select Committee on 18 December 2006 Members considered and discussed a draft report; Members then requested that a further draft report, including draft recommendations from this scrutiny review, be brought to this Select Committee meeting.

3. Recommendation

The Select Committee is asked to consider this draft report, including draft recommendations, and then agree a final report, with recommendations which will be sent to Council Cabinet in March 2007.
