REPORT OF THE TEAM MANAGER, MEMBERS AND CIVIC SUPPORT CIVIC RECEPTION FOR ROYAL BRITISH LEGION VOLUNTEERS 16TH MAY 2012

1. Purpose

This report seeks approval for the provision of a Civic Reception to thank the Royal British Legion volunteers. This reception will be hosted by the Chairman of the County Council at County Hall.

2. Background

- 2.1 The Royal British Legion is the Chairman's chosen charity for 2011/2012. The Chairman has raised money for this charity throughout his year of office.
- 2.2. The Chairman of the Council has requested that the reception be held on the evening of Wednesday 16th May, the last evening before he relinquishes office.
- 2.3. As part of the event, the Chairman of the Council would like to present the Chairman of the Royal British Legion with a cheque for the amount he has raised for the charity during his year of office.

3. <u>Financial Implications</u>

It is estimated that there will be 100 external guests, two invitees from each branch of the Nottinghamshire RBL (42 branches) and committee members and 50 County Council representatives. The cost of a buffet reception for a maximum of 150 guests amounts to:-
