NOTTINGHAM TREATMENT CENTRE PROCUREMENT

Purpose of the Report

1. To introduce briefing on the procurement of the Nottingham Treatment Centre.

Members will be aware that a wide range of day case services are delivered at the Treatment Centre, which is located on the Queens Medical Centre campus, by the independent company Circle Health. Circle's contract to provide these services expires in July 2018. Therefore, commissioners are already commencing the development of tender documentation, with the tender period expected to run December 2017/January 2018.
- 3. Senior representatives of the relevant Clinical Commissioning Groups will attend the Health Scrutiny Committee to brief Members and answer questions as necessary.
