Thank you for your question. The County Council has already at its Transport and Highways Committee on the 20th March, resolved to make an additional contribution of £25,000 to the Special Hardship Fund subject to a similar amount being contributed from Nottingham City Council.

I would note that this is in addition to the previous contribution of £25,000 made available by the County Council for the Special Hardship Fund which Broxtowe Borough Council continues to administer.
