REPORT OF THE TEAM MANAGER, MEMBERS AND CIVIC SUPPORT EVENING MEAL AND CHARITY AUCTION FOR THE CHAIRMAN

Purpose of the Report

1. This report seeks approval for the Chairman of the Council to hold a dinner for approximately 100 guests on the evening of the 4th of May 2012. The evening will consist of a three course meal and an auction to raise money for the Chairman's Charity the Royal British Legion.

Information and Advice

- 2. The Chairman has requested that this dinner be held on the evening of Friday 4th May 2012 in the Assembly Hall at County Hall.
- 3. The Chairman of the Council for 2011/2012 has not held a ball or a civic dinner. It is intended that the majority of the guests invited will be other civic heads, Council Members and other people who have helped the Chairman through his year of office.
- 4. The meal will be ticketed at a cost of £25.00 per person for a three course meal and wine. The charge will cover the cost of the food and drinks provided, therefore there will be no cost to the Authority.
- 5. The evening will also include a charity auction to raise money for the Chairman's charity.
