INTRODUCTION TO SERVICES: EDUCATION STANDARDS & INCLUSION

Purpose of the Report

1. To provide the Children and Young People's Committee with an introductory overview of some of the key service areas within its remit.

To support the new Committee's work, officers will deliver short introductory presentations at the first four meetings, in order to provide Members with an overview of the work of the key service areas that fall within its remit. The presentations will focus in turn on the work of each division within the Children, Families and Cultural Services Department, i.e. Children's Social Care, Youth, Families and Culture, and Education Standards and Inclusion, and Public Health will give a presentation on the integrated commissioning hub for children's health services in the County.

 - Support to Schools
 - SEBD (Social, Emotional and Behavioural Difficulties) Policy and Provision
 - SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities) Policy and Provision
 - Business Development and Support.

- 5. The Committee's consideration of each of the presentations will inform the future Work Programme.
