- 2. I am able to report that at the by-election in the Rufford Division held on 20th September 2012 John Peck was elected County Councillor for that Division. Councillor Peck is a member of the Labour Group on the Council.
- 3. The overall political balance of the Council due to this election result, is now:-

Liberal Democrat Group	9
Independent Group	7
