# **Topics of relevance to Planning & Licensing Committee**

#### 1. Shale Gas

Members will be aware from recent national media coverage that arguments both for and against the exploration and exploitation of shale gas using hydraulic fracturing or 'fracking' continue to generate significant public interest.

Whilst to date no planning applications in connection with shale gas have been received in Nottinghamshire, the County Council has produced a factsheet to explain the planning and licensing processes in relation to onshore oil and gas proposals, the interaction with other relevant agencies and the consultation process that any such proposals would entail. This builds on Government guidance issued in July 2013 and aims to provide reassurance to residents and other interested parties.

#### 2. DCLG Consultation on revised requirements relating to planning applications for onshore oil and gas

Following publication of its planning guidance for onshore oil and gas, the Government has issued a consultation paper concerning possible changes to secondary legislation in relation to planning application requirements and fees for such development.

The Government's aim is to achieve greater clarity in law to in turn provide certainty to local authorities and encourage investment. The consultation invites views on suggested amendments to the standard application form, notification arrangements and how fees should be calculated. Comments are invited by 14 October 2013 and it is proposed to provide an Officer response to this consultation.

# 3. Review of Planning Application Validation Requirements

Since 2008 local planning authorities (LPAs) have been required to publish a list of information they require to 'validate' the planning applications they receive. The validation lists consists of both national requirements (including the application form,

certificate, plans, fee etc) and a local list comprising further information and assessments relevant to the scale and nature of a proposed development. NCC adopted its Validation guidance in April 2008.

Earlier this year the Government advocated a new approach to validation requiring information to be more proportionate to the scale and nature of the development proposed and recognising that applicants currently have no opportunity to challenge validation information requests from LPAs. The Government has therefore introduced amendments to the relevant Order requiring LPAs to operate a local list that is no more than two years old. Accordingly it is imperative that the County Council's local list be reviewed.

In line with issued guidance, a review of the existing list has been undertaken and proposed changes have been identified. Such changes have largely been to update the list to ensure it reflects current national planning policy guidance, the right to challenge requests for validation information, reduced circumstances when Design and Access Statements are required, applicable standing advice, the Council's reviewed Statement of Community Involvement and website details.

It will be necessary to consult on the proposed changes for no less than eight weeks before any revised local list can be finalised and published. Accordingly it is proposed to take a report to Policy Committee on 16 October 2013 seeking agreement to the proposed changes and approval to commence a period of consultation.

Members are therefore asked to note the above and a further report will be brought back for information detailing the outcome of the anticipated consultation exercise.
