What's Child Protection?

It is all the things that are done to stop someone hurting or harming you.

What does making enquiries mean?

It means that we need to talk to people who know you and your family like your teacher, doctor, youth worker etc to find out if you are safe.

What's going to happen to me?

It will depend on what people say to us. We will talk to you about how best to help you and your family.

What's next?

We may do nothing if we think you are safe, or your family might be offered help, or we may have a meeting if we are worried you are not safe, called a conference.

Everyone who talks to you will be listening to you. What YOU say is very important to us.

Your family will be with you if we think you are safe. If the person we think has hurt you lives with you they may be asked to move out until we have talked to everyone.

Where will I go?

If it is not safe at home until we have talked to everyone, you may need to stay with other family members, friends or foster carers (people who provide a home for children).
