ADMISSIONS POLICY
ADMISSION TO SCHOOL

All Saints Harworth C of E (Aided) Primary School has an admissions policy that is controlled by the governors of the school.

The school has an admissions number of 25. Where applications for vacant places are being considered the following criteria will be applied in the order listed below:

1. The child is 'looked after' or in care
2. The child has siblings already attending the school*
3. Parents/Carers are practicing members of the Church of England (Attendance once a month)
4. Parents/Carers are practicing members of any other Christian denomination
5. Parents/Carers are desiring a Christian education for their child
6. The proximity to the school as the crow flies.

* Sibling must be on role at the time of admission to school.

Children with statements of SEN which names the school will be admitted without the application of the above criteria.

The school holds a waiting list which is kept until the term before entry and is used where previous acceptances are declined.

At All Saints Harworth C of E School the Governors operate a 'Rising Fives' admissions policy. The policy is in line with the Government's Statutory Legislation which came into effect on 1st September, 1998.

A 'Rising Fives' admission policy means that children are admitted to the main school at three points in the school year.

- Children who have their fifth birthday between 1st September and 31st December (inclusive) will be admitted on the first day of the Autumn Term.
- Children who have their fifth birthday between 1st January and 31st March (inclusive) will be admitted on the first day of the Spring Term.
- Children who have their fifth birthday between 1st April and 31st August (inclusive) will be admitted on the first day of the Summer Term.

ADMISSION TO ALL SAINTS HARWORTH EARLY YEARS UNIT

All Saints Harworth C of E is an Aided Church of England School and the admission of children to the Early Years Unit is controlled by the Governors of the school.

Admission to the Early Years Unit at the age of four is controlled by the six ordered priorities in our policy. A limit of 25 pupils will be admitted in a year group

Applications are looked at one year in advance of the academic year during which the child will enter the Early Years Unit. Applications received after this will be considered after those which were received by the closing date.

You will be informed of the decision during the second week of September.

There will be an open morning on the first Saturday in October from 10.00am to 12.00pm.
