

ARCHBISHOP CRANMER CE Primary School

APPLICATION FOR FIRST ADMISSION PLACES IN PRIMARY EDUCATION 2009/10

Children will be admitted to the foundation class in September if their fifth birthday falls between September 1st, 2009 and 31st March, 2010. Children whose birthday falls between 1st April, 2010 and 31st August, 2010 will be admitted in January at the start of the spring term. Applications for first admissions may be made at any time but should be received, at the latest, by 12.00am on 12th January, 2009 for pupils due to commence Primary education in the academic year 2009-10.

Applications will be acknowledged and notification of places offered will be posted by 27th March 2009. In the case of late applications the school will admit these using the criteria below for catchment and non catchment children.

A waiting list of unsuccessful applicants will be held until 31st August 2009 and then discarded. If places become available before then offers will be made in accordance with the order of priority listed below.

ADMISSION CRITERIA - CATCHMENT

In the event of over subscription, the following criteria will be applied, in priority order, to determine which applications will be granted:

- 1 Looked after children.
- 2 Children whose parents are committed, active and frequent worshippers in the Church of England, as attested by the Minister, within the parishes of Aslockton, Whatton, Scarrington, Hawksworth, Thoroton and Shelton.
- 3 Children who at the time of admission have a brother or sister already in school.
- 4 Children whose parents are committed, active and frequent worshippers at Church within Churches Together in England.
- 5 Children whose parents live within the parishes listed in '2' above.

ADMISSION CRITERIA - OUTSIDE CATCHMENT

If places remain after applicants from the catchment area have been accommodated places will be allocated as follows:

- 1 Looked after children.
- 2 Children whose parents are committed, active and frequent worshippers in the Church of England, as attested by the Minister, within the parishes of Aslockton, Whatton, Scarrington, Hawksworth, Thoroton and Shelton.
- 3 Children who at the time of admission have a brother or sister already in school.
- 4 Children whose parents are committed, active and frequent worshippers of Church within Churches Together in England.
- 5 Children whose parents live nearest the school.

SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

The following children will be given special consideration in their application:

Pupils who have a statement of special educational needs where this school is named in the child's statement will be admitted.

As this is a Voluntary Aided school the Governors are able to consider applications from outside the parishes as well.
