

Census Content - What information will be available

Broadly information will be in these themes:

Demographic, Transport Labour Market, Household Accommodation	Cultural, Health, Education and Socio-economic Communal Establishments

The results encompass a wide variety of data, including:

Population: Age and gender, Religion, Ethnic Group, Economic activity, Industry, Occupation, Employment, Work status, Education, Socio-economic group, Travel to work, Health & care.

Households: Relationships, composition (one, two person, children, etc.), Living arrangements, Access to a car.

Dwellings: tenure, rooms, amenities.

Census Output - How the information will be presented

Of most interest to general users will probably be:-

Profiles, a number of figures for all areas, including parishes. The County Council, City Council and ONS will produce profiles.

Key Statistics, which will contain 500 cells, and will summarise the main aspects of the full data-sets.

More comprehensive data will be available through other tables;

Standard Tables - the most detailed data-set, available for wards upwards.

Census Area Statistics; slimmed down standard tables available for each Output Area (about 150 population).

Details of all the tables are on the Census Web site, together with a wealth of background information.

Topic or Theme reports will be available from ONS giving more detail, and Bulletins and reports from the County Council, giving analysis for the County area.

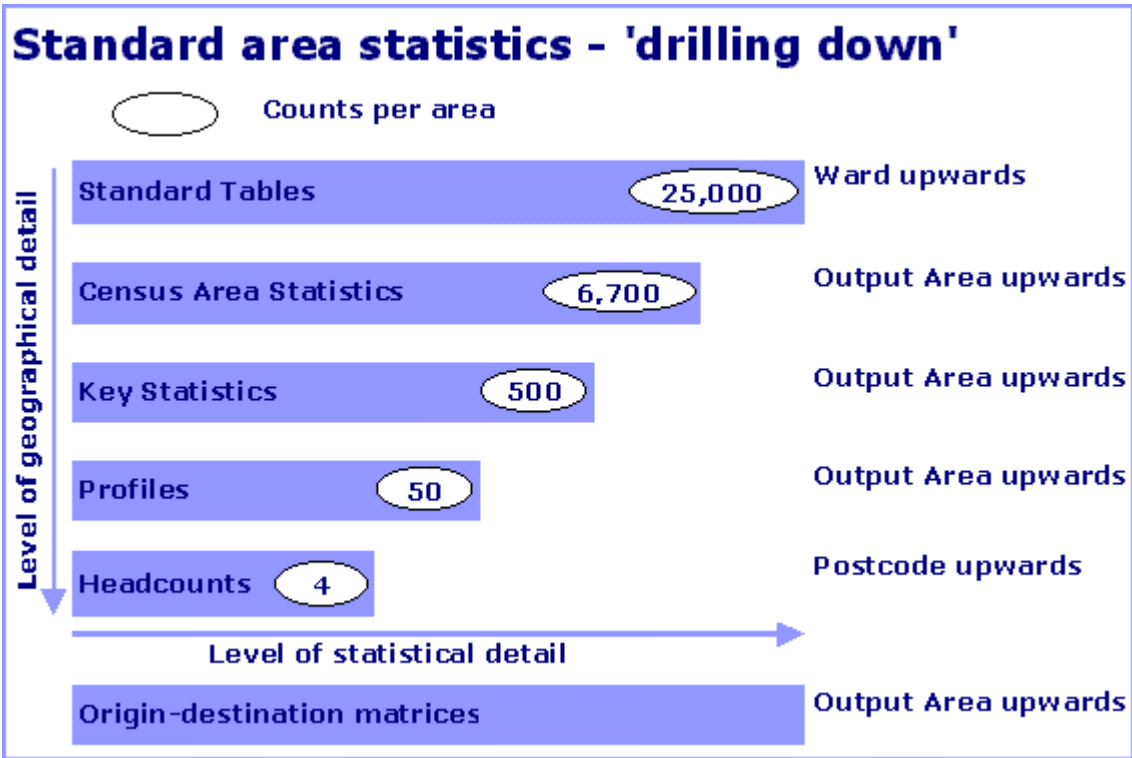
