**NOTTINGHAMSHIRE AND NOTTINGHAM
JOINT STRUCTURE PLAN**

The Examination-in-Public [EiP] into these proposals has been held and the report of the persons holding the EiP has been considered by Nottinghamshire County Council and Nottingham City Council. The two Authorities approved and published Proposed Modifications to the Plan in April 2005 inviting representations on the Proposed Modifications by 27th May 2005.

Nottinghamshire County Council and Nottingham City Council have considered the representations made and intend to adopt the proposals without making further modifications (other than modifications which the two Authorities are satisfied will not materially affect the content of the proposals).
