Sale of Gas Lighter refills and other solvents

The Cigarette Lighter Refill (Safety) Regulations 1999

The purpose of these regulations is to prevent a dangerous substance being sold to young people and so avoid substance abuse.

The Offence

You must not sell or supply cigarette lighter fuel or any cigarette lighter refill canister containing butane to anyone under the age of 18 years.

The Penalty

If found guilty of committing the above offence, the penalty you may face is up to 6 months imprisonment, or a fine of up to £5,000, or both.

The Intoxicating Substances (Supply) Act 1985

Intoxicating substances are items such as solvent-based glues, aerosols, dry cleaning fluid, correction fluid and thinners, marker pens, 'cold-start', anti-freeze, butane (from a source other than a cigarette lighter refill) and any other substance likely to be inhaled by anyone under the age of 18.

The Offence

You must not sell or supply any substance to a person under the age of 18 knowing, or having reasonable cause to believe, that the substance (or its fumes), are likely to be inhaled for the purpose of causing intoxication.

The Penalty

The maximum penalty for the above offence is up to 6 months imprisonment, or a fine of up to £5,000, or both.
