

Features: A new country park created partly on the pit heaps of Clipstone Colliery. Completed and opened in summer 2000, the park offers the visitor:-

- Lakes for angling and wildlife.
- Spectacular views from the top of the hill.
- Excellent bird watching opportunities.
- A visitor centre with disabled toilet, refreshments and meeting room.

Opening Times:

- The country park has open access, gate indicated (**G**) close to visitor centre is locked from dusk to dawn.
- For opening times of the visitor centre, or to book the meeting room, telephone (01623) 424836.

Location:

- Main entrance signed from Mansfield Road, B6030, opposite Clipstone Social Club.

- Buses: Telephone Buses Hotline 0870 608 2608.

Paths and gates:

- A range of routes from short and gentle to longer, but relatively easy, circuits and climbs. Routes from 3/4 mile to 2 1/2 miles.
- Most paths are made of compacted red ash (**B**) and are suitable for most wheelchairs and scooters.
- Long, but rewarding gradients (**B2** to **B5**) to the top of the hill.
