


## Traffic Management Act Noticing Requirements




**NOTE**

1. Temporary traffic control as defined on page 53 Safety at Street Works and Road Works 'A Code of Practice'.
2. Mobile Works and Minor Works carried out from a single vehicle as defined on page 66 Safety at Street Works and Road Works 'A Code of Practice' e.g. valve operation, grass cutting, gully emptying, lighting maintenance. (This does not include mobile or single vehicle works which deploy additional measures such as matrix sign vehicles, crash cushions or lane closures or additional fixed or mobile traffic management.)
3. Opening is defined as lifting, removing or opening inspection covers, gully grates etc.
4. Width reduction includes due to works vehicles
5. Lane reduction includes due to works vehicles

Day = Working day (Monday - Friday excluding bank holidays)

**NOTE**  
 7. Dotted boxes are only required under the corresponding circumstances.  
 8. If dates are to be revised a new notice should be submitted with the updated information.  
 9. When reinstatement is to interim standard only, a Works Clear Notice must be submitted. Reinstatement details (whether interim or permanent) must also be notified. Refer to Notice Requirements Matrix and Code of Practice (for the Co-ordination of Street Works for Road Purposes and Related Matters) for full details.
