Assessment Statutory Moderation and SATs Monitoring

External moderation of teacher assessment and monitoring of the administration of KS2 SATs is a statutory duty for the Local Authority. Moderation needs to be undertaken for EYFSP, KS1 reading, writing and maths and KS2 writing. Should a moderation visit be required as part of the normal cycle of moderation the following service will be provided:

- KS1 Reading, Writing and Maths and KS2 Writing Moderation.
- Attendance at LA moderation briefing.
- Scrutiny of a range of work and evidence provided by the school/academy.
- Discussion of the school/academy's processes for determining accurate assessments of pupils against the interim frameworks for teacher assessment.
- Determine the accuracy and strength of the school/academy's judgements.
- Provide verbal feedback to a senior leader at the end of the visit.
- Provide a written report to the school/academy of the outcomes of the moderation process.

Maintained schools

The LA undertakes these activities, free of charge in maintained schools.

Academies

Academies must choose which LA is responsible for moderation and SATS monitoring. They should inform STA of their choice by the end of the autumn term.



Academies who choose Nottinghamshire LA will be included in the LA's normal cycle of moderation. This will mean the academy may receive no visit or one or more visits in any particular year. The academy will be charged only for those visits that actually take place at a rate of **£250** per visit.
