Thank you for your recently submitted Freedom of Information Request. I am not able to provide you with the information supplied by the relevant departments.

Adults

These are 272 adults currently receiving support and will have epilepsy as a 'minor category' in that, in itself it's not a support reason.

Mainly captured as 'other' under health condition or health needs.

Children

We have taken "people ... who receive some form of care/financial support package" as children who are currently Looked After.

Of the 783 children who were looked after on 31st August, 2 had been diagnosed with Epilepsy.
