Thank you for your recent Freedom of Information Request; below I have laid out the questions you asked, and our responses to them.

1. "A complete list of names/locations of "Byways open to all traffic" in the Nottinghamshire area including grid references and total mileage of the afore mentioned."

This information is readily available and is already published via the following link, although I appreciate that this is not in the most easily accessible format (i.e. a list), <a href="https://www.rowmaps.com">www.rowmaps.com</a>.

2. "Also any "Boats" that have had Traffic Regulation Orders (TRO) placed upon them including also the reasons for the TRO's, start dates and end dates."

The following BOATs have seasonal TROs; in essence the byways are closed to vehicles with 3 or more wheels from 1st November to 30th April - see the attached Order;

Beckingham Byway No 16/ Walkeringham No 14 Clarborough Byway No 22 Hayton Byway No 4/Hayton Byway No 7 Marnham Byway No 8 Misterton Byway No 18 Misterton Byway No 24/Walkeringham Byway No 11 North Leverton Byway No's 11, 14, 15/Cottam Byway No 5 South Leverton Byway No 14 South Leverton Byway No 15
