

Aim of the Childcare Business Sustainability Officer: To develop and maintain the viability of all businesses across the childcare sector in Nottinghamshire.

 Rationale for the work: Legislation places a duty on local authorities to secure sufficient childcare for working parents. Developing the business management skills of early years and childcare providers is essential to ensure that they have every opportunity to make their business a success. The culture of the sector has meant that business skills are not as highly valued as the ability to provide safe and secure provision for children.  How is support offered? Requests direct from Childcare Providers. Referrals made by the EY teacher team and advisors. Provider Support Meeting recommendations. 	 Priorities: Management committees of voluntary sector Out of School Clubs and Pre-schools are a particular area where support is needed, due to frequent changes in the committee membership. Childcare Providers, where there is a deteriorating trend in their finances. Assisting with the planning and implementation of the extended Free Entitlement Funding for eligible 3 and 4 Year Olds.
