Further to your recent Freedom of Information request, please see below in response.

Our sub-contractor framework contract did end in 2017 and we have just completed the tendering of a replacement framework contract.

Places on the new framework contract to supply Via were awarded on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> February 2018 and letters sent out to the successful tenderers by Corserv. The Alcatel standstill period ends on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> February 2018. There are just under 60 individual contractors on the framework spread across multiple lots.

Our current intention is that the first orders will be placed with our new framework sub-contractors with effect from Monday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2018.

The new sub-contractor framework runs for two years with options for two further extensions of one year each. The anticipated spend is around £3.5m per annum.
