Thank you for your recently submitted Freedom of Information Request.

I am now able to provide you with the information supplied by the relevant department, as follows:

The information supplied is for Nottinghamshire County Councils Roads only. It excludes the Trunk Roads (Highways England) and Nottingham City Councils Roads. ALSO 2017 IS INCOMPLETE and the data is only to 31-10-17. The figures are for **reported injuries** i.e. resulted in slight, serious or fatal injury to the pedestrian in 1, 2 or 3 and cyclist in 4,5 & 6.
