ACTIVITIES INCLUDE:

Investigate forces through simple air/water rockets. Learn about the science behind getting a rocket to take flight through comparing the amount of water needed and the angle of the rocket.

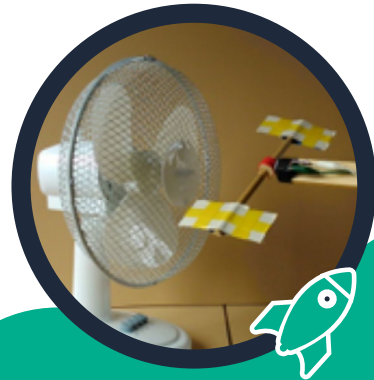
