We recently sent you a letter about measuring «FirstName»'s height and weight in school as part of the National Child Measurement Programme and the measurements have now been done. Seeing if your child's weight is within the healthy range for their age, sex and height can help you make informed choices about their lifestyle.

These results suggest that your child is above the healthy weight range for their age, sex and height. These measurements are a guide, and do not take into account your child's diet or activities which may affect their Body Mass Index (BMI). Some medical conditions or treatment that your child is receiving may mean that BMI is not the best way to measure your child. Your GP or other health professional caring for your child will be able to discuss this with you. Sometimes there are some simple changes that you and «FirstName» can make such as being more active and eating more healthily which can make a difference.
