

New to childminding quick access factsheet

If you are thinking of becoming a childminder, you may be wondering where to start. There are two options to register as a childminder. You can register with Ofsted who will carry out checks on you and others over 16years old in your household. Ofsted will come to your home and carry out a registration visit to ensure you are suitable to work as a childminder. Contact Ofsted on 0300 123 1231

You can also choose to register with a childminding agency who are registered with Ofsted. The agency will ensure you are suitable to work as a childminder for the agency. For more information contact @ home childcare on 0115 978 3399. A quick guide sheet is available at

You can sign up as a childminder on Notts Help Yourself to be visible to potential parents. On the website you can also find information on the Local Offer regarding children with SEND (special educational needs and disability) needs. This is a great resource of information to signpost parents to if they have a child with additional needs.
