Nottinghamshire commissions transport for SEN or short breaks and where specific training is required this is included in the procurement specification. The transport providers must ensure that the crew are trained appropriately whether it's manual handling or medical training. This is funded from either the SEND Transport budget held by Transport & Travel Services or the Short breaks budget held by Children's Services.
