For clarity: Capital spend is here considered to be the money "the council spends ... on improving the council's assets, then this is capital expenditure. This would include purchasing new assets, such as land and buildings, but also refurbishing and improving existing ones." And revenue spending is "the council's day-to-day expenditure and includes salaries and wages, running costs such as fuel, utility bills and service contract payments."

The response from the department:

Nottinghamshire County Council (NCC) has been allocated funding from Central Government for Brexit related expenditure as follows

2018/19 £87,500 – received 2019/20 £87,500 – received.

To date no expenditure has been allocated against this.

NCC has incurred internal staff costs relating to monitoring risks, assessing impacts on critical services and Brexit related communications and liaison work across a range of service areas including Trading Standards, Adult Social Care and Emergency Planning.
