To whom it may concern.

Coronation Road in Woodthorpe is a short residential street between Breck Hill Road and Woodthorpe Drive. It is clearly signposted at each end with a red circled sign (no motor vehicles) and the words 'Except For Access'

In furtherance of concerns made by residents in the area about traffic continually using Coronation Road in contravention of this restriction, I would like to know the following background information.

- 1. When was this restriction imposed?
- 2. What were the reasons?
- 3. Were other streets in the area also considered?
- 4. What complaints have been made regarding it?
- 5. What enforcement action has been taken.

Thank you for your recent Freedom of Information Request.

I am now able to provide you with the information supplied by the relevant department.

1. When was this restriction imposed?

The restriction on Coronation Road came into force on 14<sup>th</sup> December 1992. (attached) Committee report Paragraph 6 and 7 mentions Coronation Road.

As a result of the Mapperley Plains Traffic Management scheme and subsequent signalisation at the top of Woodthorpe Drive.

2. What were the reasons?

To deal with issues of unnecessary through traffic and parking problems.

3. Were other streets in the area also considered?

Parts of Bonington Road and Gretton Road also received Prohibitions of Driving as part of the scheme

4. What complaints have been made regarding it?

Current records only go back to about 2007, most are not actually complaints against the scheme itself in principle and enforcement complaints would go to the Police rather than ourselves as we have no powers to enforce these restrictions, only the Police do.

5. What enforcement action has been taken.

The Police would have this information, not ourselves.
