Dear Requester,

Thank you for your request for information relating to traffic signals, street lighting and highways work.

You requested spends on access chambers, covers and sockets installed for the last year.

I can confirm that we are withholding the cost element information under S43(2) of the Freedom of Information Act on the grounds that release would be likely to prejudice the commercial interests of Viaem / Nottinghamshire County Council.

Before reaching this decision, we considered whether the public interest in withholding this information outweighed the public interest in disclosure. Releasing the specific costs, you requested would significantly prejudice the commercial interests of those companies in any future tender process. It would provide a significant advantage to their direct competitors and would considerably affect their ability to operate effectively in the competitive marketplace.

It is our conclusion, therefore, that on balance the public interest lies in withholding this information. We could supply total numbers purchased and the product specifications if this would be of any use to you, please let me know.

I am sorry I cannot be more helpful.
