The footpath goes through brambles onto waste ground (previously land belonging to the Miner's Welfare). It then veers slightly to the right and doubles back on itself and goes over the River Meden (there are stepping stones in the water clearly designating the path).

It then follows a very distinct and clear path to the right of the River Meden, following the River Meden practically all of the way to a barrier which goes directly into the grounds of Skegby Hall Gardens.

Hopefully one 'selling point' of having this footpath adopted, is that it would then be an official right of way from Brierley Forest Park to Skegby Hall Gardens, and would add to the footpath network in the county.

This path is also a very pretty path and it would be a really lovely extension from the official right of way from Brierley Park to Skegby Hall Gardens and by default, also then leading to the Skegby Trail.
