Could you tell me how's many trees in Radcliffe village are owned and maintained by the council on kerbsides and roads? (excluding park land / nature reserves) E.g there are 4 on Golf Road in Radcliffe.

Can this information be split by the number of trees each year for the last ten years?

We currently have **440** individual trees growing within the adopted highway with a further **180** trees plotted as groups within the ward name Radcliffe on Trent.

The above figure shows numbers of trees at the date of last inspection and unable to show of population over previous years.

Also are there plans to plant any further trees or help maintain the existing ones to ensure a long and healthy life as part of the village landscape and help with improving the overall green wealth of the area? If so what are the plans for the next 12 months?

Our last inspection has identified several locations recommended to be planted once funding becomes available and these locations are:
