I am writing to you in reply to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to Nottinghamshire County Council about wildlife conservation areas. I have the following information.

We do not collect information in the way requested (i.e. on a site by site basis) but can give overall figures for the County Council's Green Spaces:

We manage 72* open spaces for wildlife and public access, covering 1,311 ha and including 5 Local Nature Reserves and parts of 5 Sites of Special Scientific Interest (* excludes agricultural land and access roads).

The total budget for managing these sites (including staffing costs for the staff directly involved in managing the sites and income from grazing lets etc) in 2018/19 was £253,131. In addition, Green Spaces staff managed volunteer input on these sites in 2018/19 totalling 9,304 hours.
