

**NCC-042641-19 Design of the pedestrian crossing at the junction of Lower Kirklington Road and Station Road Southwell**

Dear Requester,

Further to your request for information under the freedom of information act, please see below and attached.

The county council's policy is set out in the attached committee report. The results of the recent PV<sup>2</sup> survey are also attached. Following receipt of the attached data, officers agreed to brief Via East Midlands, the county council's highway design company, to undertake a study to determine the cost and feasibility.

Due to the complex nature of the location, this work is on-going and any future outcomes will be publicised for public consumption. As such we have applied the following exemption in part for your request.
