I am writing to you in reply to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to Nottinghamshire County Council. Firstly, I apologise for the delay in replying to you and hope that it has not caused any inconvenience. I have the following information.

*Please provide the latest accident record at the Oldcotes traffic signal junction.*

We hold records of the reported injury accidents at the junction. That is to say, accidents which the Police attended or had reported to them which involved injury to one or more people.

The latest data available is up to 30.11.19; there were 3 injury accidents in 2019 up to that point.

The most recent injury accident in our records occurred in June 2019.

It is sometimes the case that major junction layout alterations exhibit an initial 'spike' in accidents as people get used to the changes. However, the signals design is a relatively commonplace crossroads arrangement seen at numerous similar locations elsewhere, so we are continuing to monitor the situation.
