This FOI request is regarding the government's £600m adult social care infection control fund announced in May.

Please can you tell me if it was a condition of receiving the funding that care homes must pay full pay to any care workers self-isolating, and which care homes failed to comply with this condition?

Please can you also tell me if any care homes did not get the second tranche of funding for not meeting the conditions of the funding and for what reason this second tranche was not handed out in each case.

In each instance, please include the name of the care home and the location.

No it is not a condition of the Infection Control Fund Grant that care homes must pay full pay to any care workers self-isolating.

All homes in Nottinghamshire who received the first instalment also received the 2nd instalment.
