I have absolutely no idea of the claims made against others and would not know where to start to obtain such data.

That is partly because it is actually (subjectively, I think) relatively low / infrequent but it is also widely spread. The response to the questions I can answer is below.

Roughly £2.4m but the previous defined split between Capital Maintenance and Revenue are not prescriptive as they have been historically. There is recognition nationally that capital investment in the asset to resolve early deterioration through a planned mechanised approach can provide a more timely solution. This is reinforced by the WMHI ACOP and the move away from nationally implemented solutions.
