Information as follows:

1. Urban Network - 2 to 3 times, Rural Network - 1 to 2 times 2. Urban Network - 2 to 3 times, Rural Network - 1 to 2 times 3. As per NCC Highway Network Management plan - Urban Network 5 times per annum, Rural Network twice per annum 4. There was a later start to the cutting season due to Covid 19, and therefore both programmes are slightly behind where we would normally expect them to be.
